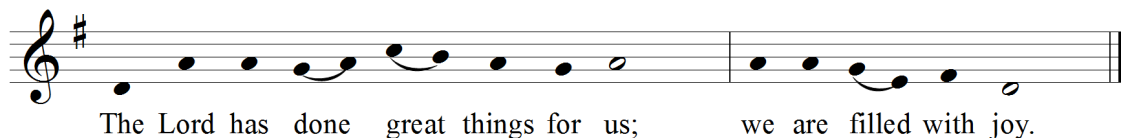

\*Kyrie eleison, Christe eleison, Kyrie eleison.

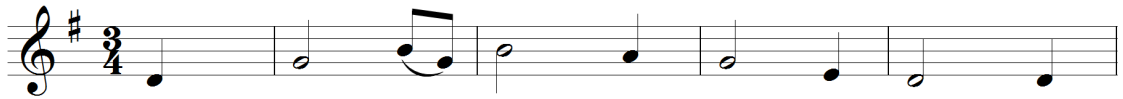

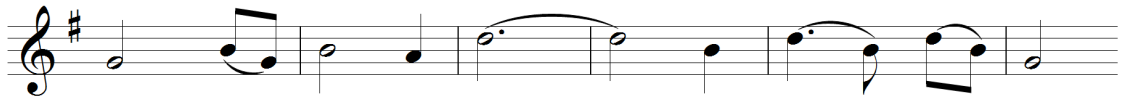
