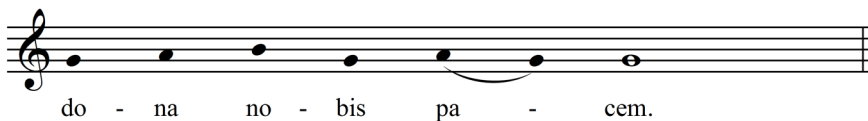


COMMUNION RITE

4PM & 8:30AM—COMMUNION ANTIPHON & GLORY BE (*Roman Missal*): JN 12:24; Ps. 116

*cantor only*: Amen, Amen I say to you: Unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies it remains a single grain. But if it dies, it bears much fruit.

Verse 1: How can I repay the Lord for all his goodness to me? The cup of salvation I will raise; I will call on the name of the Lord.

Verse 2: My vows to the Lord I will fulfill before all his people. How precious in the eyes of the Lord is the death of his faithful...Glory be to the Father, and to the Son...

11:15AM—COMMUNION ANTIPHON (*Roman Missal & Propers*): JN 11:26; Ps. 130

*choir*: Everyone who lives and believes in me will not die forever, says the Lord.

Verse 1: (*choir*) Out of the depths I cry to you, O Lord; Lord, hear my voice! O let your ears be attentive to the sound of my pleadings. *R./*

Verse 2: (*choir*) If you, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But with you is found forgiveness, that you may be revered. *R./*

Verse 3: (*choir*) I long for you, O Lord, my soul longs for his word. My soul hopes in the Lord more than watchmen for daybreak. *R./*

Verse 4: (*choir*) More than watchmen for daybreak, let Israel hope for the Lord. For with the Lord there is mercy, in him is plentiful redemption. It is he who will redeem Israel from all its iniquities. *R./*
