Dear PSR Parents,

I hope your school year has gone well. In this packet you will find information about registration for PSR for next school year. We are planning on starting classes on September 13, 2026. Classes will all be in person in the school building. In the packet you will find registration forms and permission forms. We need a separate permission form for each student. We are sending out all the forms at once to be sure they are completed and submitted as part of registration. We hope you can fill out the form as the summer begins but it will need to be back no later than **August 1** so that textbooks can be ordered and arrive on time. All forms and fees must be submitted before classes start. **August 30th at 9:50 AM in Old Church will be a Parent Meeting for all students and parents.**

This year we will be offering in class PSR for grades 1-8.

- **Grades 1-6**
 - *In class – Sundays from 9:50 – 10:50AM* starting **September 13, 2026**. These will be held at the school campus in the elementary building. (All students wanting to join 2nd grade class need to finish 1st grade first)
- **Grades 7&8 (Confirmation Preparation)**
 - *In class – Sunday Nights from 6:45 – 8:15PM* starting **September 13, 2026**. These classes are currently scheduled to be at the school campus in the Jr. High building. These classes are for Confirmation preparation so attendance is very important. If a class is missed, makeup work will be assigned.
 - In special circumstances remote learning can be requested. Your child will use the same materials as the classroom which includes online resources. There will be questions turned in monthly for the work done at home. You will not be able to switch to in class midway through the year. To get the best Confirmation experience please consider in person classes on Sunday nights.

Registration Information

1. Please fill out all of the forms as completely as possible **and print clearly**. It is important that we ask for this information each year as a check for our records and to ensure that we have the most accurate information possible for emergency needs. Please let us know during the year if any information changes. Thanks for your help!
2. **Students will not be permitted to begin class unless all forms have been received.**
3. As in the past, students who wish to be confirmed in the 8th Grade are required to have completed the 7th Grade curriculum as well. It is important for families to be aware that many Catholic parishes now require people to have received all of the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation – before they can be married in those churches or serve as Godparents there.
4. As in the past, all students need to finish 1st grade PSR or Religion classes before being allowed to enter the 2nd grade for First Reconciliation and Communion. Students will be moved to first grade if they have missed these 1st grade classes. This is to make sure they are prepared to receive sacraments.
5. To register – we need a COPY of the baptismal certificate **for each new student** to our PSR program, unless they were baptized here at St. John’s Parish. If they were baptized here, please indicate that on the appropriate form together with the date of Baptism. If you do not know the exact date, please do your best guess and indicate that on the form as well.
6. **Fees are due before entering the classroom unless other arrangements are made with the Director of Religious education.** The parish, of course, helps as well, but it is our responsibility to be good stewards of the money donated by parishioners each week.
7. The fees for this year are:
 - **First through 6th Grade PSR - \$70.00**
 - **Seventh and Eighth Grade - \$90.00**
 - **Families with four or more children - \$230.00**

The fee includes everything for the year. There will be no requests for additional fees. If you cannot make the full payment, we ask that you try to make a partial payment and attach a note explaining when you intend to pay the remainder of the fee.
8. **Please do not allow financial difficulties to prevent you from sending your child for PSR.**

There is assistance available from anonymous donors. (If you would like to donate to this fund, please contact the Religious Education Office.) All information will be kept confidential. If there were financial difficulties last year, which are occurring again this year, please attach a note to let us know.
9. **You may return your forms and fees one of several ways.**
 - a. Parish office - Mail them or drop them off at the parish office.
 - i. Office hours are 9:00 AM-5:00 PM.
 - b. Email the completed forms to jschaefer@stjb.net and send a check through the mail. (All checks for PSR fees should be made out to St. John the Baptist Parish.) Other copies of the Registration Forms are available on the parish website.
 - c. Mass Collection – Drop them off in a sealed envelope in the collection basket at church and address attention PSR registration.

Arrival and Dismissal

- Parents will need to come into the building to drop off your child at 9:50 AM.
- At dismissal, parents will need to come to the child's classroom for grades 1-4 to sign them out. Please try to be there by 10:50 as many of our catechists go to 11:15am mass.

Classroom Instruction

- Individual desks will be used by all students. Desks will be distanced with the maximum amount of space between as size of classroom permits.
- Grades 7-8 are asked to attend all youth ministry junior high events throughout the year as they are announced.

Food

- Water fountains will be available for bottle- filling purposes.
- Volunteers and students can bring in a water bottle to fill up at water fountains.
- Food may not be brought into classroom by students, unless directed by catechist.

We rely on the integrity and honesty of those who apply for our Parish School of Religion programs to be faithful to the commitment they made in the past and renew for this year.

To attend our Parish School of Religion, a baptismal certificate from a Catholic Church (if St. Johns, please check line at bottom of this page) or a certificate of full communion with the Catholic Church is to be submitted with the application for the first year of attendance.
