This Week's Bible Verse

“Sing to the Lord a new song.” – Psalm 96:1

Today's Lesson, Chapter 5: Celebrating Penance and Reconciliation

We learn about the peace and unity that comes from receiving God's forgiveness and love through the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation.

- The Bible is full of parables, which are stories that Jesus told his followers. Jesus used these stories to help them know how to be Christians. Jesus often used parables to teach a lesson of some kind.
- Begin to read chapter 5, on page 52, and stop when you get to the purple words “We receive God's forgiveness...” You just read the parable of the lost sheep. What does this parable mean? Jesus loves all of us. God will seek out those who are lost and offer them mercy and forgiveness; we just have to ask. We can ask for forgiveness during Mass and also in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation (sometimes just called ‘confession’). At St. John, the Sacrament is available on Tuesday nights from 6:15-7:00, Saturday mornings from 8:00-9:00, or anytime by appointment.
- Continue reading the rest of pages 52 through 55. Don't skip the green box on page 52 or the “As Catholics...” box.
- After reading all of page 55, pause for a moment to think about Saint Paul. Even today we can continue to follow St. Paul's advice. What did Saint Paul do/say?
 - St. Paul taught the people about Jesus Christ
 - St. Paul wanted early Christians to treat each other with respect.
 - St. Paul taught that the people should take care of the needs of others in the community.
- Now return to page 54 and read the Act of Contrition prayer again (bottom part of the page, under blue line). Take a few moments to reflect on the prayer and think about what the prayer's words mean to you.
