#### **This Week's Bible Verse**

#### **Today's Lesson, Chapter 8: Learning About God's Law**

*We learn about God's covenant with Moses and the Israelites, the promise God kept by sending his Son, and Jesus' teaching about God's law.*

- Our lives are filled with rules. We have to go to school, do homework, do this, don't do that.
- It is important to follow rules and instructions for the safety of ourselves and others, and to make us better people.
- Read chapter 8, on pages 76-79. Don't skip the text boxes!
- Go back again to page 77 and read The Ten Commandments again. These are the commandments, or laws, that God lays out for us. These laws are like an instruction manual for how to be a good Christian. The first 3 laws help us to show love and respect for God. Numbers 4 through 10 help us show love and respect for ourselves and others.
