

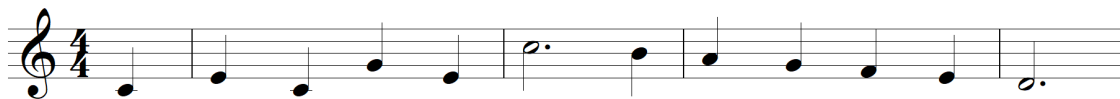

GATHERING SONG: *Rejoice, the Lord Is King*

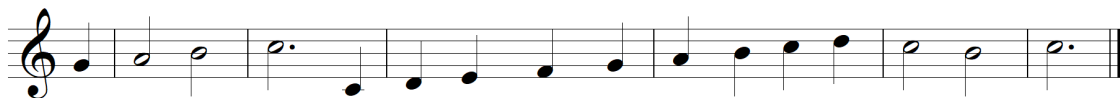

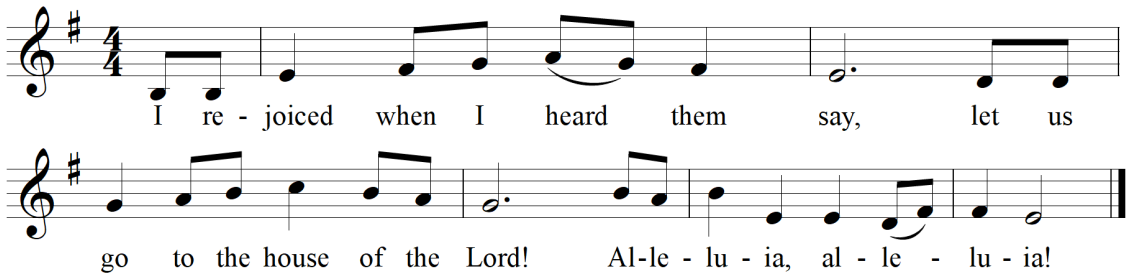
