The names of the faithful departed of the past year are read.

In between groups of names the following acclamation is sung by the cantor and then by all:



I call you, Lord; come now to help me! O hear my voice, I cry out to you. And let my prayer rise before you like incense, my outstretched hands like an evening offering.

In all my words, Lord, be my guardian, Keep steadfast watch at the door of my lips! Turn not my heart from your road, from your wisdom; keep me from those who would turn me from your love.

Keep me from sharing the feast of the wicked, if I am struck let me answer with love. Protect my soul from the proud and their boastings, my humble prayer as a shield against the foe.
