
L confess to almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do,




THE CALL TO CONTINUING CONVERSION (SUNDAY 11:15AM)





COMMUNION RITE






