

#### PENITENTIAL RITE


L confess to almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do,





At the words that follow, up to and including the Virgin Mary, all bow:


who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary,


Unless a grain of wheat falls to the earth, falls to the earth and dies, it remains only a grain of wheat and never the blade shall rise.






