

**2020 PARISH PICTORIAL DIRECTORY
SOME GENERAL INFORMATION**

- **Why are we doing this?**
 - We want to have a new parish pictorial directory to help us build a greater sense of community as we grow and to get to know one another by putting names to faces! In addition, we will have the directories in time to celebrate the anniversary of the dedication of our new church late next spring (June 1, 2020).
- **How do I make a photography appointment?**
 - You may schedule your appointment online or in person at the hospitality desk before and after all Masses the weekends of Sept. 28/29, Oct. 5/6, and Oct. 12/13. To make an online appointment, go to www.ucdir.com to access the site. The username is OH2308 and the password is smile4. You will not be able to access the scheduler from 12am on Saturday to 12am on Monday. This enables us to make in-person appointments during the weekend Masses.
- **When will the photography sessions take place?**
 - They begin on November 19 and will go through early December, depending on need.
- **Where will the photography sessions take place?**
 - New Church Conference Room
- **How long will the whole process take?**
 - 45 – 60 minutes – your pictures are taken; you will have the opportunity to view your proofs; you'll select one picture for the directory and can order portraits if desired.
- **What should I wear?**
 - Solid colors look best, especially medium to dark density colors. Bright colors also look attractive. Prints, plaids and stripes are not recommended for aesthetic value. However, you should wear what reflects your family and their lifestyle.
- **How much does it cost?**
 - It's free. You'll receive a free 8 X 10 portrait and receive a free directory. You may purchase additional pictures if desired.
- **When will my/our pictures be ready?**
 - Your individual/family portraits will be ready by Christmas!
- **Why should I/we do this?**
 - We want all our parishioners' pictures in the parish directory so that we can see and celebrate our community!
