All: **Lord, make haste to help me.**

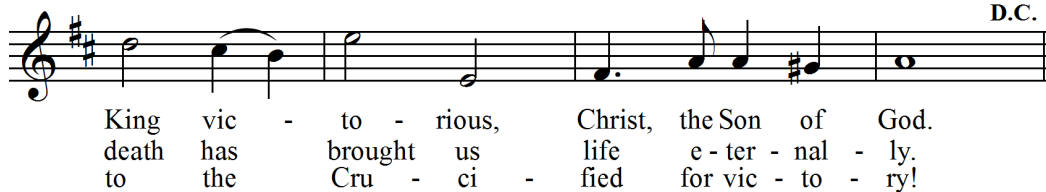
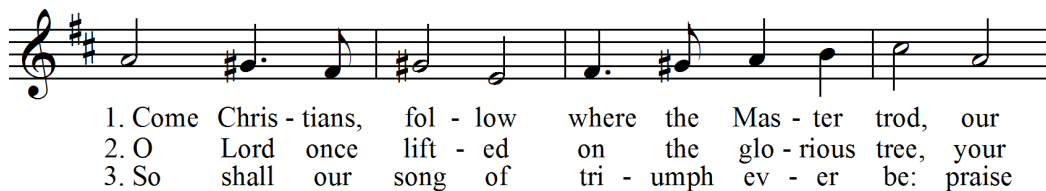
(All make a profound bow during the naming of the Trinity.)
