Today's Lesson, Chapter 2:

 - Activity: Cut a cross out of construction paper, and decorate it this can be added to your prayer space. Grab a piece of paper – write 5 actions that show love. - Begin reading chapter 2 on page 28. I recommend reading aloud. Then pause to look at the pictures on pages 28 & 29, why do you think Jesus is surrounded by people? What are the two girls doing and the father and son? See our KEY WORDS are in red Bible & Kingdom of God.
- On page 30 & 31 we read about faith, Jesus dying for us, and Jesus rising form the dead. Key Words: Faith, Crucified, and Resurrection. (Don't forget to read the 'As Catholics' blue box)
