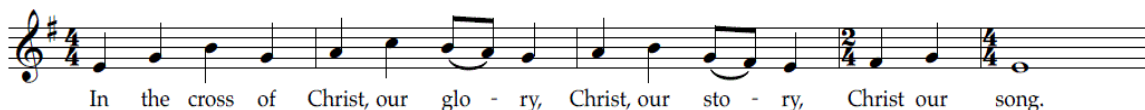

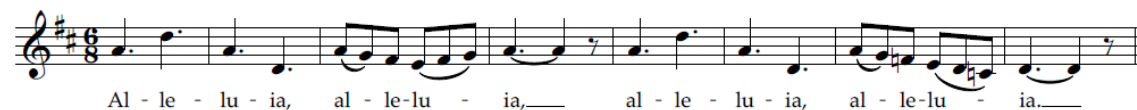



### COMMUNION ANTIPHON: (Graduale Romanum/Roman Missal): Baruch 5:5; 4:36

Cantor: Jerusalem, arise and stand upon the heights, and behold the joy which comes to you from God.
