



Vs 1: The heavens declare the glory of God, and the firmament proclaims the work of his hands. Day unto day conveys the message, and night unto night imparts the knowledge R./

Vs 2: No speech, no word, whose voice goes unheeded; their sound goes forth through all the earth, their message to the utmost bounds of the world. R./

Vs 3: There he has placed a tent for the sun; it comes forth like a bridegroom coming from his tent, rejoices like a champion to run his course. R./

Vs 4: At one end of the heavens is the rising of the sun; to its furthest end it runs its course. There is nothing concealed from its burning heat. R./

Vs 5: The law of the Lord is perfect; it revives the soul. The decrees of the Lord are steadfast; they give wisdom to the simple. R./

Vs 6: The precepts of the Lord are right; they gladden the heart. The command of the Lord is clear; it gives light to the eyes. R./
