Death and Resurrection: Christ our Savior



Christ Himself will be the Judge.



Jesus' Death and Descent to Hell

- Jesus bears the weight of our sin on Himself.
- When He died, His body hung on the Cross, but His soul went to the realm of the dead.
- The Gospel was preached to the dead to free them from exile.



The Paschal Mystery

- Jesus truly died and truly rose.
- The Resurrection is the “crowning truth” of our Faith.
- His death and Resurrection is called the Paschal Mystery.
- By Baptism, we enter into this Paschal Mystery



Ascension: Christ our Intercessor



Jesus sits at the right hand
of His Father.



Christ intercedes for us to the Father

- Christ pleads for us before the throne of God.
- We can share in Christ's work of praying to God for others.



Christ will come again

- Jesus will come again in glory and power.
- Until that time, we wait, trust, and obey.

The Two Judgments

- The particular judgment
- The Last Judgment



At the Last Judgment, God's
entire plan will be revealed.





Key Points in Our Readings This Month

- † Jesus descended into hell to open the way to Heaven for the just who had died before Him.
- † Jesus rose from the dead.
- † The Paschal Mystery is the Passion, death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- † Salvation is a process that begins with Baptism and continues throughout our lives.



Key Points in Our Readings This Month

- † Jesus made it possible for us to go to Heaven by paying the eternal price of sin.
- † Jesus ascended into Heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father.
- † Since Christ's Ascension, the world has been in the last days. The Church will pass through a final trial before the triumph of Christ's Kingdom comes.
